- 2. <u>Action Item:</u> Paul moved to submit a District Letter of Commitment or Support for development of a Valley County Waterways Management Plan. John seconded and the motion carried.
- 3. <u>Action Item:</u> Paul moved to approve the ICF Shelton Foundation Advised Fund Grant Application as submitted for community and youth educational outreach \$2,000
