- c.U.P. 22-05 Gold Fork Reserve Extension Request: Landmark Pacific Investors LLC is requesting a one-year extension of the conditional use permit and preliminary plat approval that expire on August 1, 2024. Approval was for a 28-lot single-family residential lots and six open space lots. Access would be from private roads onto one access point onto Gold Fork Road (public). The 80-acre site is parcel RP16N04E294206 in the W ½ Section 29, T.16N, R.4E, Boise Meridian, Valley County, Idaho. Action Item.
